Introduction:

Also, consumers are more concerned about their appearance. Therefore, they utilise a variety of herbal-infused beauty products to look young. Herbal cosmetic has high demand on the global market because of their potent effects and comparably less or absence of adverse effects as compared to synthetic medications. Spices and herbs have been utilised to preserve and improve human beauty. It offers more safety for human health. These new concepts had improved the use of natural extracts as active ingredients in cosmetics.^[1]

Cosmeceuticals:

Cosmeceuticals are the next generation of skin care products. They are the new pillar of skincare as well as the advancements made in the field of dermatological products. Cosmetic-pharmaceutical hybrids known as cosmeceuticals are frequently used to improve the health and appearance of skin. All cosmeceuticals contain functional substances with either medicinal, disease-fighting, or healing capabilities, some of which are naturally derived and others of which are synthetic.^[9]

The idea of beauty is not exclusive to women; males are now becoming more conscious of how they appear. Many anti-wrinkle and fairness cream advertising today target men. Men commonly use astringents, anti-aging, antiperspirants, hair growth treatments, and antiperspirants for athlete's foot. The cosmetics that women use the most frequently are those that target wrinkles, cellulite, hair, tanning, skin whitening, antioxidants, and cell recovery products.^[9]

Classification of Cosmeceuticals:

Various terms may be used in conjunction with the phrase "cosmeceuticals." The concept of "cosmeceuticals formulations"- which includes all terms-remains the same: substances that are neither pure drugs (such as corticosteroids) nor pure cosmetics (such as lipsticks). Between prescription medications and cosmetics, this hybrid product category exists. Cosmeceuticals can also be referred to by the following other names: active cosmetics, nutricosmetics, performance cosmetics, functional cosmetics, and dermaceuticals. The following categories are a general breakdown of cosmetics: Cosmeceuticals basically can be classified into following categories:

- 1) Skin cosmeceutical products Antiaging creams, moisturizers, Facial products and Lotions.
- 2) Hair cosmeceutical products Gel and creams, Hair colorants and Dyes, Shampoos, Growth Stimulators and Conditioners.
- 3) Other products Lipstick, Nail polish, Toothpaste and Powders.

Skin Cosmeceuticals:

Cosmetics known as "cosmeceuticals" have medicinal or drug-like properties and can alter how the skin functions biologically because of the functional components they include. These are skin care items that go beyond colouring and adorning the skin by promoting collagen formation and preventing the damaging effects of free radicals, and enhance the skin's functionality and texture, protecting the integrity of the keratin structure and promoting skin health. An exterior skin care product with an olive plant extract as a skin-beautifying component, specifically as an anti-aging and/or skin-whitening component, was patented by Kuno and Matsumoto. For cosmetic use, a dry emollient formulation with monounsaturated jojoba esters was utilised. Martin used a plant extract from the genus Chrysanthemum in a cosmetic formula to promote pigmentation in the skin and/or hair.

Face Serum:

Cosmetic serum is a highly concentrated product of the active ingredients. It is made up of smaller molecules that can give a very high concentration of active substances to the skin by penetrating deeply into the epidermis. This makes them an excellent tool for certain skincare issues, like as pigmentation and age indications. It made a good attention due to the rapid growth of serum formulations in cosmetic industry particularly in skin lightening products. ^[2]

Significance of face serum over other products:

Serum has a property of rapid absorption and ability to penetrate into deeper layers of the skin together with its non-greasy finish and intensive formula. When concentrates are used, the skin quickly receives the necessary amount of active ingredient to facilitate easier absorption. These product on application reduces sagging of skin, pigmentation due to ageing. Serums also help by preventing wrinkle formation and improving the appearance of the skin. [2]

Face Serum Vs Face Moisturizer:

Serum is a lightweight, highly concentrated formula infused with key ingredients that target specific skin and penetrate the skin's surface up to 10 layers deep, targeting the appearance of damage, while discussing about moisturizers which have larger molecule size which affect only the surface layer, helping to lock in hydration and create a shield against external stressors that can exacerbate existing skin problems.

Types of Serum-based on cosmetic use:

• Anti -aging serums

It encourages skin renewal and collagen production [4]

• Skin brightening serums

They consist of anti-oxidants and pigment fighting ingredients to improve skin tone, like vitamin C, glycolic acid, kojic acid, mushroom extract, liquorice root or lactic acid.

• Hydrating serums

It contains hyaluronic acid, a molecule that physically binds water in the skin to make it look fresh and younger. These serums often contain vitamin B5, which helps to hydrate skin, making it appear smother and more hydrated.

Anti-oxidant serums

Free radicals that might harm healthy skin are combatted by antioxidants. To help prevent skin damage from free radicals, choose a serum that contain ingredients like vitamin C, A, E and resveratrol.^[6]

• Sensitive skin and acne serums

They often contain salicylic acid on similar plant-based derivatives.^[8]

• Skin texture serums

To help boost skin texture and the overall appearance of skin, serum with glycolic acid is recommended. In order to expose smoother skin, it can also assist shed dulling, discolored and dead cells.

How to use serums:

Use of serum also depends on the season and climate. For normal and dry skin in hot climates, concentrates based on water are used, whereas antimicrobial concentrates are used in conjunction with them for oily skin since they have a minor drying effect. In winter or variable climate, oil bases of any cosmetics, whether a cream or a concentrate are advised. To get the maximum benefits from a serum, we must use it as per the label recommends. Serum should generally be applied before heavier products. Always apply the serum after cleansing because you want the active components to absorb as much of the skin as possible before using other creams that might form a barrier. [12]
