To strengthen cooperation and support from higher levels of government, Thu Duc needs to build partnerships, participate in regional linkages and cooperation networks, develop development projects, and strengthen infrastructure. information and communication mechanism. These solutions will create favorable conditions for Thu Duc to receive support and cooperation from higher levels of government, contributing to the sustainable and autonomous development of the city.

Conclude

Building mechanisms and policies to promote autonomy for the Thu Duc city government is an important task to ensure sustainable development and strengthen the decision-making power of the community. Requirements include ensuring transparency and publicity, people's participation in policy decisions, as well as building public monitoring and control mechanisms, and improving self-governance capacity.

However, to implement autonomy, Thu Duc must face several challenges and difficulties. Limited resources and human resource training are of important challenges that need to be addressed to ensure local government staff have enough capacity and knowledge to perform their duties. Furthermore, support and cooperation from higher levels of government also play an important role in promoting autonomy and ensuring Thu Duc's decision-making power.

To overcome these challenges, Thu Duc needs to apply appropriate solutions and directions. First, investing in training and improving grassroots management capacity is an important solution to meet the requirements of autonomy. Thu Duc needs to create conditions for grassroots government employees to learn and improve their professional, leadership, and management skills. At the same time, strengthening cooperation and support from higher levels of government is also an important factor. Thu Duc should establish partnerships and seek support from Ho Chi Minh City and government levels. central government, through participation in regional links and cooperation networks.

On that basis, Thu Duc needs to identify and implement policies and mechanisms to promote autonomy. This could include creating a welcoming and supportive environment for grassroots elected organizations and councils, ensuring transparency and openness in policy decisions, and building oversight mechanisms and public control. Thereby, Thu Duc's autonomy will be promoted and open up opportunities for sustainable development for the city.

In the future, Thu Duc's success in building autonomy will depend on the commitment and cooperation of all stakeholders, from local authorities to communities and government levels. higher. Only when everyone agrees to cooperate and join hands to build, can Thu Duc become an autonomous, transparent, and sustainable city in the future.

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
